***Harald Felgenhauer***

Harald Felgenhauer obtained degrees in law and history/political science from the University of Vienna, Austria. He gained early experiences in European and US policy making at the Viennese Office of EU Commissioner Franz Fischler and at the United States Conference of Mayors, Washington D.C., respectively.

Following a junior function in the Austrian Ministry of the Interior in preparation of Austria's first EU Presidency in 1998 he joined the European Police Office Europol in The Hague, NL, where he contributed to the young organisation's build up as a legal advisor, a directorate support officer and finally as the Head of Information Integrity. Having returned to Austria in 2005 he supported the MoI during Austria's second EU-presidency, inter alia as chairman of Europol's Management Board.

Subsequently, Mr. Felgenhauer was tasked to build up a centre for security policy and strategic planning within the Austrian MoI. Since this year he heads the MoI's newly founded Security Policy Unit. The unit deals with security policy both on national level and within the MoI, strategic planning and security research. The unit is also in charge of representing the MoI in Austria's National Security Council.
